And what to do if you might want to buy a (hybrid) heat pump?


I actually didn't think about that until we talked about it in our sustainability group. Because in most cases, you will be surprised by the failure of your current central heating system and won't have enough time to think long and hard about possible options. So hereby we want to invite you to think about that now, just in case.


There are a few things to consider. First of all, a heat pump is quite an investment, and you might not have that kind of money in your bank account. Fortunately, you will earn this amount back in time, and there are subsidies available. Depending on your income, you can borrow money interest-free, but that requires thinking ahead.

You also might like to know in advance how big a heat pump is; will it fit in my house? The indoor unit may be smaller than my central heating boiler, but where do I place the outdoor unit? And how much noise does such a heat pump make? Can I put that on myself and the neighbors?

Fortunately, there are neighbors in the neighborhood who already have a (hybrid) heat pump. We have asked them if we can visit them with some other interested neighbors, and we are welcome to do so. Please let us know if you would like to join us.

However, you may be worried about whether you'll get heat enough in your home. What else do you need to do for insulation? Or you have questions about other solutions like infrared, PVT, air conditioning or

Book club



On Sunday, 23 March, the book club will be held. This time we're reading 'Raadselvader' (Riddle Father) by Jolande Withuis. We will start at 14 hours/2pm. Do you want to participate in this session, please let us know by mailing Peter Cambier at p.cambier@planet.nl.

The famous chess journalist Berry Withuis (1920-2009) was raised in a reformed family. As 12-year-old he lost his faith in God. Later he became a communist and editor at 'De Waarheid' (the truth), a newspaper. His daughter Jolande (1949) grew up with her father's political views, but as she grew up, she became an admonished critic of communism. This paved the way for her into authorship and science, but it also drove a

wedge between her and her father. After his death she couldn't get over the fact that she never really got to know her father as a person, while she had admired him so much while growing up. In the book 'Raadselvader' she tries to reconstruct his life with the help of his national security file, amongst other documents.

Withuis creates a sharp and moving view on her relationship to her father which reflects our recent world history. The book shows the reader a view of the Cold War from the inside: "I was five years old, but I knew: we are the enemy."
